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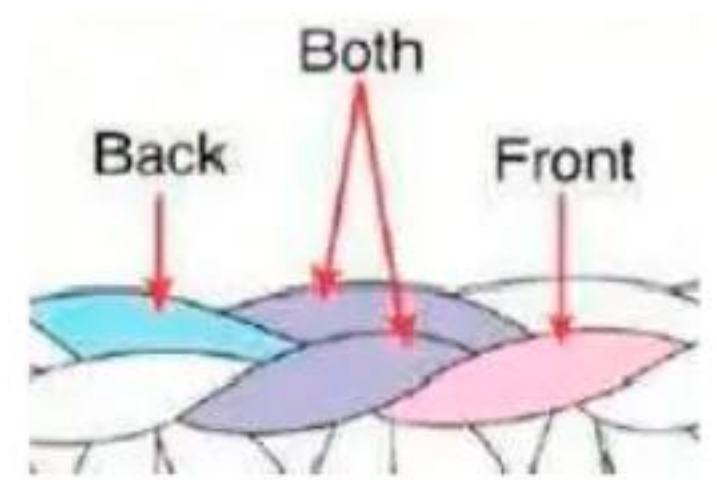

Tips for crocheting toys.

1. I use Yarn *Alize Cotton Gold* and *YarnArt Jeans* for crocheting toys. You can find this yarn on Etsy marketplace. You can use any other yarn, but then choose an appropriate size of a crochet hook.
2. Be sure your stitches are tight enough without any huge gaps. If the gaps are there in a crochet fabric, just try a smaller size of a hook.
3. Do not forget to replace a stitch marker into the first loop of every other row. Use a plastic stitch marker, pin or piece of thread in a contrast color.
4. You have to fill up the crocheted Toy as tightly as possible to shape it better. Use the hollowfiber or any appropriate filler.
5. To sew on the details of the doll, use the thread from the yarn that was used to crochet the part.
6. Invisible part ending
 - Skip next stitch. Insert the needle into both loops of next stitch, pull yarn through. Insert the needle through the back loop of the starting stitch and tighten it just enough so that the join looks like a regular stitch.
 - Depending on the part you are working on you should leave the long tail to sew later or weave in the end.Please, look at the pictures 1-6.



7. In this pattern you have to work with Back Loop (**BLO**) and Front Loop (**FLO**). To find this loops, look at this picture.



8. Attach a thread of a different color:

- Crochet the last loop of the main color until the last two loops of this loop are on the hook (pic. 7)
- Then use a yarn of a new color, to do this, pull it through two loops on the hook (pic.8). Crochet with a new color (pic. 9) .



Materials.

1. Yarn **Alize Cotton Gold** (330 meters/100 grams):
 - N° 499 Caramel - 1 skein
 - N° 26 Dark brown - a small amount for a nose
2. Yarn **Gazzal Baby Wool** (175 meters/50 grams):
 - N° 813 Blue - 0.5 skein
3. Yarn **Alize Angora Real 40** (430 meters/100 grams)
 - N°450 White - a small amount for a sweater
4. Plastic safety eyes 10 mm
5. Felt circles diameter 15 mm (you can find it on Etsy)
6. Crochet hook 2 mm
7. Stuffing material (hollowfiber or polyfil)
8. Scissors & needle

Abbreviations.

Ch – chain stitch

MR – magic ring

Sc – single crochet

Sl st – slip stitch

Inc – increase (2 sc into the same stitch of previous row)



Dec – decrease (2 sc together)



Dc – double crochet

IncDc – 2 dc into the same stitch of previous row

Inc3sc – increase (3 sc into the same stitch of previous row)

Hdc – half double crochet

DecHdc – 2 Hdc together

(...) * n – means that you should repeat the combination of stitches n times.

Ears (make 2).

Use **Caramel** yarn.

1 round: 6 sc into MR

2 round: inc * 6 times (12)

3 round: 12 sc

4 round: 5 sc, inc * 2 times, 5 sc (14)

5 round: 6 sc, inc * 2 times, 6 sc (16)

6 round: 7 sc, inc * 2 times, 7 sc (18)

7 - 12 rounds: 18 sc (6 rounds)

13 round: 7 sc, dec * 2 times, 7 sc (16)

14 round: 16 sc

15 round: 6 sc, dec * 2 times, 6 sc (14)

16 - 17 rounds: 14 sc (2 rounds)

18 round: 6 sc, dec * 2 times, 4 sc (12)

19 round: 12 sc

Cut the yarn and fasten off.



Head.

Use **Caramel** yarn.

1 round: Ch 5. Starting in the second chain from the hook:

3 sc, 3 sc into the last stitch of the chain;

Along the other side of the chain: 2 sc, inc (10)

2 round: inc, 2 sc, inc * 3 times, 2 sc, inc * 2 times (16)

3 round: 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, (sc, inc) * 3 times, 2 sc, (sc, inc) *
2 times (22)

4 round: 22 sc

5 round: 12 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 3 sc (25)

6 - 7 rounds: 25 sc (2 rounds)

8 round: 13 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc (28)

9 - 11 rounds: 28 sc (3 rounds)

12 round: inc, 10 sc, inc, 16 sc (30)

13 - 14 rounds: 30 sc (2 rounds)

15 round: 2 sc, IncDc * 4 times, inc * 4 times, IncDc * 4 times, 16 sc (42)



16 round: 1 sc, (2 sc, inc) * 8 times, 17 sc (50)

17 round: 50 sc

18 round: 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 16 sc (56)

19 round: 5 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 19 sc (60)

20 - 21 rounds: 60 sc (2 rounds)

22 round: 54 sc (put a marker here)

Note! Make sure that the marker is exactly in the middle of the bottom of the head, if not, then make an additional sc for offset.



When crocheting together with ears, insert the hook into a ear and into the head simultaneously.

Note! When crocheting together with the ear, it is important that the part of the ear where the increases is crocheted is directed downwards (Please, look at the pictures 17 - 22).

23 round: 17 sc, 6 sc together with 1st ear, 14 sc, 6 sc together with 2nd ear, 17 sc (60)

Please, look at the pictures 17-20.

24 round: 17 sc, 6 sc along the 1st ear, 14 sc, 6 sc along the 2nd ear, 17 sc (60)

Please, look at the pictures 21-22.





25 round: 60 sc

Make holes in the circles of felt, insert the eyes there and set them in the **15th round**, between **6 Dc** and **7 Dc** on each side.

26 round: 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec) * 5 times, 4 sc (54)

27 round: 54 sc

28 round: (7 sc, dec) * 6 times (48)

29 round: 48 sc



30 round: (6 sc, dec) * 6 times (42)

31 round: (5 sc, dec) * 6 times (36)

32 round: (4 sc, dec) * 6 times (30)

Stuff the head.

33 round: (3 sc, dec) * 6 times (24)

34 round: (2 sc, dec) * 6 times (18)

35 round: (sc, dec) * 6 times (12)

36 round: dec * 6 times (6)

Tighten the final gap with the help of the tapestry needle: insert the threaded needle into the front loop of every stitch and slightly pull. Fix the yarn tail and hide it inside the detail.



Needle sculpt the eyes.

To needle sculpt, use a **Caramel** yarn.

Insert the needle into point No. 1, which is located in the 15th round, exactly in the middle of the lower part of the head
(Please, look at the picture 29).

Withdraw the needle from the right side under the right eye
(Please, look at the pictures 30 and 31).



Next, insert the needle by counting 2 sc to the left and withdraw it out of the stitch **neighboring to No. 1** (Please, look at the pictures 32-34).

Tighten the yarn and make a knot.



Using the same yarn, repeat these actions for the second eye. Tighten the yarn, make a knot, and hide the yarn tails inside the toy.



Nose.

Use **Dark brown** yarn.

1 round: 6 sc into MR

2 round: (1 sc, **Inc3sc**) * 3 times (12)

3 round: 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc (15)

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Pin the nose to the head and sew it on.



Legs (make 4).

Use **Caramel** yarn.

1 round: 6 sc into MR

2 round: inc * 6 times (12)

3 round: (sc, inc) * 6 times (18)

4 round: **BLO**: 18 sc

5 - 8 rounds: 18 sc (4 rounds)

9 round: (inc, 5 sc) * 3 times (21)

10 round: 21 sc

Cut the yarn and fasten off.



Tummy.

Use **Caramel** yarn.

1 round: Ch 22, Starting in the second chain from the hook:

20 sc, 3 sc into the last stitch of the chain,

Along the other side of the chain: 19 sc, inc (44)

2 round: inc, 19 sc, inc * 3 times, 19 sc, inc * 2 times (50)

3 round: 1 sc, inc, 19 sc, (sc, inc) * 3 times, 10 sc (put **1st marker** here), 2 sc (put **2nd marker** here), 7 sc, (sc, inc) * 2 times (56)

Use thread contrasting color as a marker
(Please, look at the picture 45).

4 round: 2 sc, inc, 6 sc.

Cut the yarn and fasten off (fasten the thread in the way described in paragraph 6 in the “Tips” section [here](#)).

Please, look at the picture 45.

Make **1 chain stitch** at the end of the thread, in the same way as you make when you crochet a chain of chain stitches (Please, look at the picture 46).

5 round: Attach the thread in the place where you placed the **2nd marker**:

To do this, insert the hook into the stitch next to the **2nd marker** and insert the chain stitch into it (Please, look at the pictures 47-48).



Make **Ch 1** (picture 49) and then crochet according to detail (picture 50): 8 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 12 sc.

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Please, look at the pictures 51.



In the same way, join the thread of the next round, only in the stitch next to the **1st marker** (pictures 52-53).

6 round: Ch 1 and crochet in a spiral:

8 sc, **attach the legs:**

5 sc together with the 1st leg, 3 sc

5 sc together with the 2nd leg, 18 sc,

4 sc together with the 3rd leg, 2 sc,

4 sc together with the 4th leg, 9 sc (59)

When crocheting together with legs, insert the hook into a leg and into the tummy simultaneously (Please, look at the picture 54).



Body,

Crochet in spiral.

To avoid gaps, make an **additional sc** in places where we attached the legs to the tummy (Please, look at the picture 59).

1 round: 9 sc, 17 sc (along the 1st leg), 3 sc,
17 sc (along the 2nd leg), 18 sc,
18 sc (along the 3rd leg), 2 sc,
18 sc (along the 4th leg),
9 sc (111)

Please, look at the pictures.

2 round: 27 sc, inc, 1 sc (put the main marker here, all further rounds will start from this marker).

3 - 11 rounds: 112 sc (9 rounds)

Stuff the legs.



12 round: 7 sc, dec, (14 sc, dec) * 6 times, 7 sc (105)

13 round: 105 sc

14 round: 37 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 42 sc (101)

15 round: 101 sc

16 round: 8 sc, dec * 2 times, 25 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 29 sc, dec * 2 times, 8 sc (93)

17 round: 93 sc

18 round: 35 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 38 sc (89)

19 round: 35 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 37 sc (85)

20 round: 35 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 36 sc (81)

21 round: 35 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 35 sc (77)

22 round: 35 sc, dec * 4 times, 34 sc (73)

23 round: 16 sc, 42 sc skip, 15 sc (31)

Please look at the pictures.



Neck

Crochet in spiral.

24 - 25 rounds: 31 sc (2 rounds)

Don't cut the thread!

Stuff the body.



Divide the yarn into multiple threads, use one of the threads to connect the right and left side of the back. Use blanket stitch

(Please, look at the pictures).

Continue crocheting the neck .

Use the other end of the thread in the skein.

Make 1 chain stitch at the end of the thread, in the same way as you make when you crochet a chain of chain stitches and attach the thread to **the 12th sc of the neck** in the same way as you did when you crocheted the tummy (Please, look at the picture 76).

26 round: **In 12th sc of the neck:** 8 sc

Cut the yarn and fasten off (Fasten the thread in the way described in step 6 in the Tips section [here](#)).



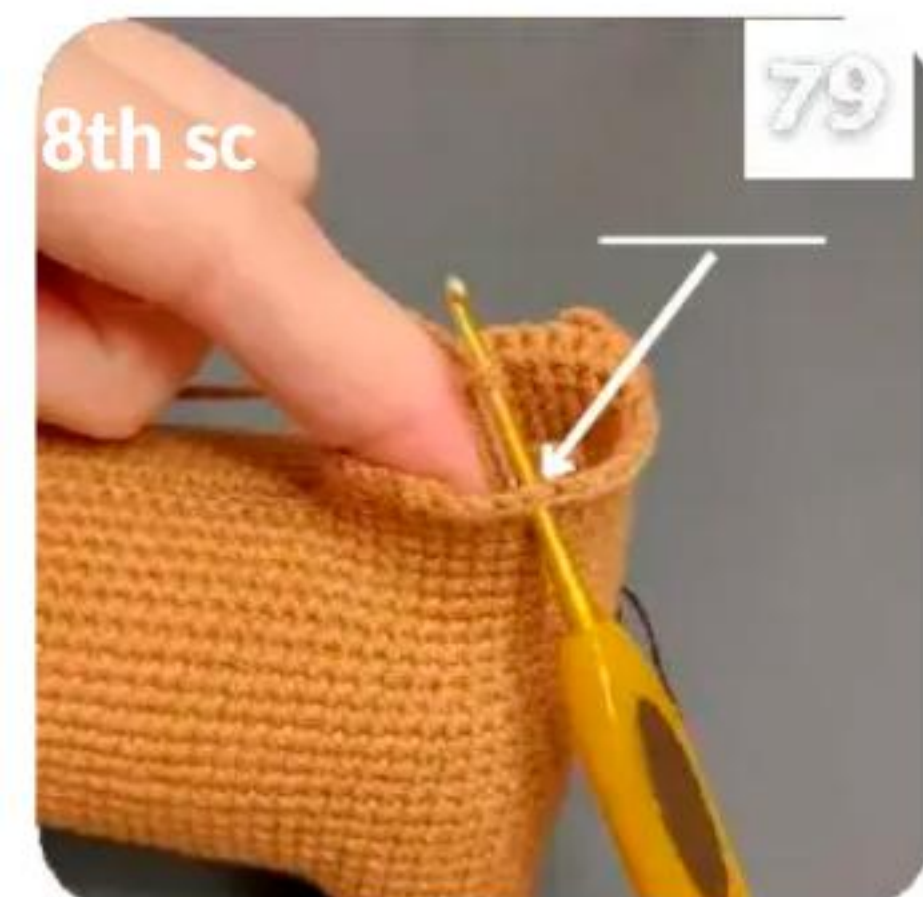
27 round: crochet the same way as the 26th round, just start from the 8th sc of the neck: 16 sc

Cut the yarn and fasten off (Fasten the thread in the way described in step 6 in the Tips section [here](#))

28 round: crochet with the main thread: 31 sc.

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Stuff the body.



Using pins, attach the head to the body and sew
(Please, look at the pictures).



Tail.

1 round: 6 sc into MR

2 round: (2 sc, inc) * 2 times (8)

3 round: 8 sc

4 round: (3 sc, inc) * 2 times (10)

5 round: 10 sc

6 round: (4 sc, inc) * 2 times (12)

7 - 10 rounds: 12 sc (4 rounds)

11 round: 5 sc, dec, 5 sc (11)

12 round: 11 sc

13 round: 5 sc, dec, 4 sc (10)

14 round: 10 sc

15 round: 5 sc, dec, 3 sc (9)

16 round: 9 sc

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Stuff the tail and sew to the body between 16 and 19 rounds
(Please, look at the picture).



Sew the tips of the ears to the head in the places indicated by the arrows; all you need to do is make a couple of stitches.



Sweater.

Use **blue** yarn.

Crochet a sweater not tight.

Collar.

1 row: Ch 13,

2 row: Starting in the second chain from the hook: 12 Sl st.,

Next, crochet in turning rows, behind the back loop only of the previous row, making a turning chain at the end of each row (Please, look at the pictures 1, 2 and 3).

(Please, look at the pictures 93, 94 и 95).



3 row: BLO: 12 Sl st

4 - 61 rows: BLO: 12 Sl st (58 rows).

Fold collar in half and crochet for both walls 12 Sl st (Please, look at the pictures 96-101).



Fold the collar horizontally in half and crochet in a circle on both sides of the collar 60 sc (1 round).

Please, look at the pictures 102-107.



In the **104th picture** the arrows show where to insert the hook when doing sc in the 1st round (Please, look at the picture 105).



From the 2nd to the 5th rounds you will need to change the color of the yarn. Please use the way described in paragraph 8 of the “Tips” section [here](#).

- 2 round:** (white 2 sc, [blue 3 sc](#)) * 12 times (60)
- 3 round:** (white 1 sc, [blue 1 sc](#), white 1 sc, [blue 2 sc](#)) * 12 times (60)
- 4 round:** white 1 sc, [blue inc, 1 sc](#), white 1 sc, [blue 1 sc](#),
(white 1 sc, [blue 2 sc](#), white 1 sc, [blue 1 sc](#)) * 11 times (60)
- 5 round:** white 1 sc,
[blue 1 sc, inc. 2 sc](#), white 2 sc,
([blue 3 sc](#), white 2 sc) * 10 times,
[blue 3 sc](#), white 1 sc (62)

Don't cut the threads (**main**)!



To crochet rounds 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, use the other end of the thread in a skein of blue yarn.

Make 1 chain stitch at the end of the thread, in the same way as you make when you crochet a chain stitches and attach the thread to the 5th round of the sweater in the same way as you did when you crocheted the tummy (Please, look at the picture 111-113)

After finishing crocheting each round cut the yarn and fasten off (Fasten the thread in the way described in step 6 in the Tips section [here](#))

6 round: in the 22nd sc: Ch 1, 17 sc.

7 round: in the 20st sc: Ch 1, 21 sc.

8 round: in the 18st sc: Ch 1, 25 sc.

9 round: in the 16st sc: Ch 1, 29 sc.

10 round: in the 14st sc: Ch 1, 33 sc.

11 round: Continue crocheting with the main threads: White 1 sc, [Blue 61 sc.](#)

Next, crochet all rounds with **blue yarn.**



12 round: 17 sc, Ch 11 (13 sc skip), 2 sc, Ch 11 (13 sc skip),

17 sc (58)

13 round: 17 sc, 11 sc along the chain, 2 sc, 11 sc along the chain, 17 sc (58)



14 round: 16 sc, dec, 10 Hdc, Dec Hdc, 10 Hdc, dec, 16 sc (55)

15 round: 16 sc, dec, 9 Hdc, Dec Hdc, 9 Hdc, dec, 15 sc (52)



16 round: 16 sc, dec, 18 Hdc, dec, 14 sc (50)

17 round: 16 sc, 20 Hdc, 14 sc (50)

18 - 19 rounds: 50 sc (2 rounds)

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Put the sweater on the puppy through the hind legs.



Embroider eyebrows with brown yarn.



Now your Puppy Dachshund is ready!
